Key Stage 1 Vocabulary - Geography 4 Year Overview

The Key Stage 1 long term plan has been designed to allow pupils to build an awareness of the world they live in starting with studying their immediate environment before deepening their understanding of the wider world in which they live in. Each term ensures pupils develop an awareness of key geographical concepts appropriate to their age and ability by beginning with a focus on their local area and community before delving into the wider world as the year progresses. There is a particular emphasis on the use of fieldwork to deepen substantive and disciplinary knowledge. The plan provides opportunity for pupils to study the great diversity of the people and places of the world.
